For your information, Long Prairie Packing Company, the supplier to Sinai Foods Corporation about which you inquired, has received U.S.D.A. approval for the installation of a restraining device for ritual slaughter. The equipment will be implemented within the next 60 days.

In addition, all livestock handlers at Long Prairie Packing Company will continue to be trained in the proper methods of livestock handling and provided with guidelines from 9 CFR Part 13 and the Humane Slaughter Act to instruct them in their treatment of animals.
